

NSF/NIH funding training requirement

The [NSF RCR training requirement](#) applies to anyone receiving support from the grant, including PIs, key personnel, and sub-awardees. Anyone listed on the grant, even if he or she does not directly receive funds from the grant, is required to complete RCR training. The institutional training plan must be in place at the time of the proposal, but the actual training of individuals can take place at a later time as long as that expectation is listed in the institutional training plan.

The CITI RCR course satisfies the NSF RCR training requirement.

Both NIH and NSF are now **requiring Research Security Training**. CITI Program's Research Security Training covers the required topics.

Step 1.

Once you have registered your account and affiliated it with Western Carolina University, you can begin to add courses to complete. If you are already registered, you can login to citiprogram.org and click the "My Courses" tab, select "Western Carolina University" from the Institutional Course list that results, and scroll to the bottom to click "Add a course."
